Rules of the Club – November 2016

Rules of the Game

All matches shall be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game as approved by Bowls England this to include Short Mat and Carpet Bowls

Team Captains

Team Captains shall serve a maximum of two years unless there is no candidate, when at the Annual General Meeting the majority present may ask the incumbent to continue for a further year or the Chairperson shall ask for nominations from the floor.

The voting for the team captains shall only be cast by the male members for mens positions and females for the ladies positions.

Mens Selection

Team captains shall be elected at the AGM and vice captains shall be elected at the first members meeting held each year. The four captains shall comprise a selection committee and shall meet weekly to pick the teams. In the event of a tied vote the captain for the team under discussion shall have the casting vote. If the Captain cannot attend the meeting he shall normally send the vice-captain in his place, but in the exceptional circumstance a representative from the team may attend. The appropriate person attending shall have the same powers as the captain.

Ladies Selection

The Ladies Selection Committee shall be made up of the Ladies Team Captain, Ladies Team Vice Captain, Ladies Assistant Administrator and two other female selectors, voting for at the Annual General Meeting. The ladies selection shall meet as and when required to select all competitive teams.

Teams to play friendly matches and tour matches shall be selected by the Club Captain and Club Vice Captain.

Club, County & National Competitions

In order to be eligible for these a person must be a full, paid up, bowling member. No member may play for more than one club in any competition where the winner(s) progress to a county competition. No competitor in any club mixed pairs or triples competition shall be asked to play in more than two rounds in one day.

All teams for competitive matches shall be selected on merit. Any members not regularly playing in competitive matches shall be given priority when teams for 'friendly games' are selected provided that they have indicated their willingness to play.

All competitive County or National Competitions will be selected by the Men's &/or Ladies Selection Committees.

The results of all competitive matches involving Club Teams shall be posted on the notice board by, the relevant Team or Vice-Captain.

Nomination of Players

The Mens nominated players have to be notified to the group by the required date. In order to comply with this, all captains shall meet at least fourteen days before the deadline to offer their committees views and reach agreement on the eight nominated players. The Clubs general committee shall meet at least seven days before the deadline to consider the nominations and subject to any amendment, forward them to the group men's secretary.

Clothing

All Games will be played in the club yellow & green shirts, unless stated by a higher authority.

The dress code for roll-ups can be smart casual and in the case of extreme warm weather tailored shorts. The only proviso being that bowls shoes to be worn at all times.

Results

The results of all competitive matches involving Club Teams shall be posted on the notice board by the relevant team captain or vice-captain.
